

<b>FACTS</b>	<b>WHAT DOES ADVIA CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?</b>																												
<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.																												
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Social Security Number</li> <li>• Transaction history, account balances and payment history</li> <li>• Credit history and credit scores</li> </ul> <p>When you are no longer our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>																												
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share member/customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons the credit union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

When you are <i>no longer</i> our member, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p> <p>However, you can contact us at any time to limit our sharing.</p>

What we do	
How does Advia Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Advia Credit Union collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open an account or deposit money</li> <li>• Pay your bills or apply for a loan</li> <li>• Use your credit or debit card</li> </ul> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>Our affiliates include financial companies such as Mortgage Center</i></p>
Non-affiliates	<p>Companies not already related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies (may vary regionally).</p> <p><i>Non-affiliates we share with can include insurance companies</i></p>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p><i>Advia Credit Union doesn't jointly market</i></p>
