Overview and Quick Guide Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

Our mission is to provide our members financial advantages, including quick and easy solutions to all your financial needs. During the weekend of May 29, we will be integrating your account onto our member service systems. Please make sure to review all important dates regarding any short-term access limitations you may experience.

Important Dates to Remember	
Early May	New Online Banking enrollments will be unavailable following May 7 (those currently enrolled will continue to have access until 4 p.m. ET, May 29).
Mid May	<p>Update your contact information – including your address, home and mobile phone numbers & email address (important for enrolling in new Online/Digital Banking on June 1).</p> <p>You will be mailed a replacement Advia Debit or ATM Card (to be activated and held for use following our systems integration). Continue to use your RCFCU cards through Sunday, May 31.</p> <p>On or around May 14, the onsite ATM will be unavailable for an estimated 1-2 days (and then only available for cash withdrawals until mid-July).</p> <p>External Transfers (A2A) will stop working at 2 p.m. ET on May 20. If you attempt to schedule an A2A transfer following that time, it WILL NOT process.</p>
Friday, May 29	<p>Bill Pay will stop working at 2 p.m. ET. Any bills scheduled to pay on or before May 31 will be paid without interruption. Payments scheduled to occur following this time WILL NOT occur.</p> <p>Online Banking will stop working at 4 p.m. ET. IMPORTANT: Previous Bill Payment, External Transfers (A2A), and automatic transfers set up online WILL NOT transfer to your new Digital Banking. You are urged to download and save previous e-Statement activity. Please contact us for assistance.</p>
Saturday, May 30 to Sunday, May 31	Our systems integration will be in progress. Our St. Clair branch location will be CLOSED Saturday, May 30. You may continue to write checks and use your RCFCU ATM and Debit Card.
Monday, June 1	<p>Our branches will reopen for business during normally scheduled hours. You may also chat with us online or call 844.ADVIA.CU (844.238.4228) for answers to any question about your account.</p> <p>Enroll into new Online/Digital Banking. You'll need the following to enroll: Account Number, Social Security Number, Date of Birth, Zip Code and Last Name. To complete the login, you'll receive a 6-digit Secure Access Code to your phone, mobile text or email (must be on system with Advia prior to enrollment).</p> <p>You may begin using your replacement Advia Debit or ATM Card (former RCFCU cards will automatically deactivate).</p> <p>Visit us anytime on or after June 1 for a FREE box of replacement checks!</p>

24-Hr Phone	X			On June 1, call 844.238.4228 and speak to a Member Service Representative to help you enroll for this new service.
A2A – External Transfers	X			External Transfers (A2A) will stop working at 2 p.m. ET on May 20. A2A transfers scheduled for after that time WILL NOT process. A2A information will not carry over to Advia’s Digital Banking. Please re-establish these in new Digital Banking.
Account Number			X	Your Account Number is not changing. However, your Draft ID previously used to transmit electronic transactions such as Direct Deposit will be updated to a 13-Digit MICR (see instructions for how to locate your MICR in Digital Banking)
ATMs			X	Our onsite ATM will be updated in mid-May. Through July, it will be available for withdrawals only (no deposits). Following June 1, you will have unlimited fee-FREE access at all Co-Op Network and Alliance One Network ATMs .
ATM Cards & Debit Cards			X	Your RCFCU Debit or ATM Card will continue to work until June 1. Your new Advia card WILL NOT work until June 1. Please continue to use your RCFCU card(s) through Sunday, May 31. Once you receive your new card, activate it, set the PIN and store it safely in your wallet. Your new card will be ready for use on Monday, June 1 at which time your RCFCU card will be deactivated. After June 1, provide payees updated card information for payments tied to your Debit Card.
Automated Outgoing Payments	X			Automatic pre-scheduled payments tied to your Debit Card will need to be updated for any payments scheduled on or after June 1. Learn about our Card Swap tool online for popular recurring payments like Netflix and more!
Automatic Transfers	X			Automatic transfers set up within Online or Mobile Banking will NOT transfer to your new Digital Banking (will need to be re-established on or after June 1).
Bill Pay	X			Bill Pay payments must be scheduled on or before May 29 at 2 p.m. ET (previously scheduled payments to occur through May 31 will occur on May 29 at or around 2 p.m. ET). Any payments scheduled to pay following that time WILL NOT process. IMPORTANT: Your bill payee information and history WILL NOT carry to our new Digital Banking. Download and save bill payee information and payment history prior to our systems integration to make re-enrolling easy.
Branches	X			Our St. Clair office and & drive-thru will be CLOSED Saturday, May 30.
Checks			X	You may continue to write checks, however former RCFCU checks will not be viewable within Online/Digital Banking after June 1. Visit us on or after June 1 for a FREE replacement box. You’ll only be able to see cleared Advia checks in your new Digital Banking.
Credit Card			X	Continue to use your RCFCU Credit Card following our systems integration. You will still have access to the EZ Card Info website for making online payments and be able to mail in payments (in-branch payments will no longer be available). Look for important updates about your credit card in later Summer of 2020. In the meantime, you may apply for an Advia Visa Platinum Credit Card if desired.
Direct Deposit			X	Direct Deposits to your account will continue without interruption. Direct Deposits established with your former RCFCU routing information will be honored until late 2020. When setting up any new Direct Deposits following June 1, use your new Advia 13-Digit MICR (located at the bottom of your new Advia checks as well as within Digital Banking) and Routing Number (272483633). See information about how to locate your 13-Digit MICR within this booklet.

Loans – personal and commercial			X	<p>There are no changes to terms and conditions of your current personal and commercial-type loan(s). Make payments on or before May 29 or following June 1.</p> <p>Any pre-scheduled and automatic loan payments set up on your account will continue following our systems integration, however, those set up via Online Banking will need to be re-established following June 1.</p> <p>Credit Life or Credit disability on loans will be discontinued, and we are proud to introduce MEMBER’S CHOICE™ Borrower’s Security as an alternative solution.</p>
Member Service by Phone	X			We will be unable to provide you with updated account information on Saturday, May 30. On June 1, at 8 a.m. ET, please call us at 844.238.4228.
Mortgages			X	In May, members with mortgage loans currently held with Member First Mortgage will receive notification introducing you to our partner Mortgage Center, including updated account number information and payment instructions.
Online Banking	X			<p>Before May 29, you are urged to download, save or print copies of previous transaction history that will not be transferred to your new Digital Banking.</p> <p>4 p.m. ET on May 29, Online Banking will stop working leading up to our systems integration.</p> <p>IMPORTANT: Your previous Online, Bill Pay, External Transfers and automatic transfers set up online WILL NOT transfer to your new Digital Banking. You are urged to download and save previous e-Statement activity.</p> <p>On June 1, download our mobile app or use your desktop to enroll into new Online/Digital Banking. You’ll need the following to enroll: Account Number, Social Security Number, Date of Birth, Zip Code and Last Name. To complete the login, you’ll receive a 6-digit Secure Access Code to your phone, mobile text or email (must be on system with Advia prior to enrollment).</p>
Remote Deposit (Mobile Check Deposit)	X			This is a new service to be available to you on June 1 once enrolled within our new Digital Banking (Remote Deposit also available for Business members).
Statements and e-Statements		X		Download, save or print e-Statements leading up to our systems integration as they will not carry over to your new Digital Banking. Your May statement will be mailed in early June (even if enrolled with e-statements). If a previous statement is needed after June 1, please contact us.
Website Access			X	Visit www.adviacu.org/riverview for important updates and tools for navigating any changes to your account on and after our systems integration.
Wire Transfers	X			Incoming and Outgoing Wires – Domestic: We will continue to receive incoming wires through May 29. All wires performed on or after June 1 should be sent using the Advia Incoming Wire Instructions: adviacu.org/personal/wire-transfer .

Your Guide to Updated Services (Change in Terms Notice)

Please review your Advia Credit Union **Member Account Agreement & Truth in Savings Disclosure** for complete account details. To help you understand changes to your account, here are some of the key adjustments you’ll see in account naming and new features to your Advia Credit Union Savings & Checking services, effective June 1, 2020.

Christmas Club	Holiday Savings	There is no minimum balance required in this account; dividends are paid annually. In 2020, your Holiday Savings will mature on October 1; however, in years following, it will mature on November 1.
Not Previously Offered	Ultimate Savings	This Savings Account pays our highest yield for the initial four (4) statement cycles; following introductory promotional period, continue to earn premium rate on balances of \$100,000 or more.
Certificate of Deposit	Certificate of Deposit (Traditional & IRA)	<p>Now only \$500 minimum balance to open, your CDs will earn interest monthly. In addition to promotional offers, traditional terms available include 3, 6, 12, 24, 36, 48 and 60 months.</p> <p>NOTE: Advia's CDs compound and pay interest only one time monthly (at month end).</p> <p>Early withdrawal penalty based on the term of deposit: 3 to 12-month terms: 90 days interest; 24 and 36-month terms: 180 days interest; 48-month term: 270 days interest; 60-month term: 360 days interest.</p> <p>The grace period on withdrawals between terms is seven (7) days. CDs are available in traditional and IRA-type formats.</p>
Student CD	EZ Saver Certificate of Deposit	<p>Only \$50 minimum balance to open and earn monthly interest. Unlimited deposits allowed and include terms of 6, 12 and 24 months; grace period on withdrawals between terms is seven (7) days.</p> <p>NOTE: Advia's CDs compound and pay interest monthly (at month end).</p> <p>Early withdrawal penalty based on the term of deposit: 3 to 12-month term: 90 days interest; 24-month term: 180 days interest.</p>
IRA Savings	IRA Savings	Minimum balance of \$50. Dividends compounded and paid quarterly; Average Daily Balance of \$500 to earn stated rate.

Bronze Business Checking	Non-Interest Business Checking	There is no minimum balance required; 100 Free Transactions, \$0.25/transaction after; No dividends Paid; No Monthly Fees.
Silver Business Checking, Gold Business Checking	Interest Bearing Business Checking	No Minimum Balance; 200 Free Transactions, \$.25/transaction after; Dividends Paid Monthly, Tiered at Balances \$2500, \$10,000, \$25,000, \$50,000; \$8.00 Monthly Maintenance Fee.

Other Important Information About Your Account Access

Information below provides additional insights about managing your relationship with Advia and some changes you may notice about how transactions are processed on and after June 1, 2020.

Transactional Cut off Times and Processing Sequence	Effective June 1, transactions may process and post to your account at any point throughout the day and are processed in the order in which they are received.
Overdraft Protection Options	<p>Advia offers multiple options for protecting yourself from an accidental overdraft to your account (all service charges are indicated within our Service Charge Listing and are subject to change):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) We offer overdraft transfer options from other shares held on deposit (subject to \$7 per item service charge) as well as Overdraft Lines of Credit (subject to loan approval). If your account was previously set up with overdraft transfer options with RCFCU, it will be opted in as such on your Advia account. (2) You may affirmatively consent and opt in for overdraft coverage related to ATM and one-time Debit Card transactions (subject to applicable \$34.50 service charge per item); please note – if your account was previously opted in for this with RCFCU, it will automatically be opted in for this coverage on June 1; then will follow Advia’s process for maintaining eligibility. (3) For Checking overdrafts that occur (other than those indicated above), Advia offers non-contractual Courtesy Pay Overdraft Tolerance (subject to applicable \$34.50 service charge per item) that may be automatically applied to your account. Advia will honor former RCFCU’s overdraft tolerance guidelines throughout June of 2020 and then your account will be subject to Advia’s guidelines. Extended Holds on Deposits	<p>In some cases, we will not make all the funds that you deposit by check available to you on the first business day after the day of your deposit. Depending on the type of check that you deposit, funds may not be available until the fifth business day after the day of your deposit. The first \$200 of your deposits, however, will be available the first business day. If we are not going to make all the funds from your deposit available on the first business day, we will notify you at the time you make your deposit.</p> <p>For additional details on the availability to withdraw funds deposited, see the section of your Membership Agreement entitled "Funds Availability Policy".</p>
